Beautifully landscaped and maintained with the support of our volunteers, the gardens feature vibrant flowerbeds, shaded seating areas, and accessible pathways, creating a peaceful haven for all.

Volunteers play a key role in running the clubs, especially the Gardening Club. The indoor Gardening Club provides an opportunity for residents to nurture plants and experience the therapeutic benefits of greenery. Seasonal activities, such as summer BBQs and autumn harvest celebrations, bring everyone together, fostering a sense of community and connection.

The sensory room on the Rosedale floor complements these experiences with a calm indoor space, featuring soft lights, soothing sounds, and sensory resources tailored to residents, including those living with dementia.

Nearby attractions, such as the University of Leicester Botanical Gardens, also offer opportunities to explore and connect to the wider community, enriching the lives of Aigburth's residents.
