We believe that care is about much more than meeting needs - it's about understanding each resident as an individual. From earlystage dementia to advanced care, the team supports residents with empathy, compassion, and expertise.

Each of the home's three floors is self-sufficient, with its own dining areas, lounges, and tea bars where residents can relax and socialise. Music therapy, robotic pets, and interactive 'magic tables' engage residents with dementia, while pet therapy sessions with Timmy the tortoise and Benny the dog bring added joy and companionship.

Regular meetings with families and residents' foster a collaborative approach, giving everyone a voice in decisions about care, activities, and dining.

With a team that's both skilled and dedicated, The Homestead ensures every resident feels valued, understood, and cared for.
