Featuring raised flowerbeds for gardening, safe pathways for gentle walks, and plenty of seating areas, the gardens encourage relaxation and connection with nature. One of the most popular areas is the courtyard patio, where residents sit out with a cup of tea in warmer weather or simply enjoying the fresh air. Gardening is a popular activity, with residents helping to plant flowers, tend to vegetable patches, and watch wildlife.

With plenty of shaded seating and colourful seasonal flowers, the gardens at Berwick Grange create a secure outdoor retreat that residents can enjoy all year round.

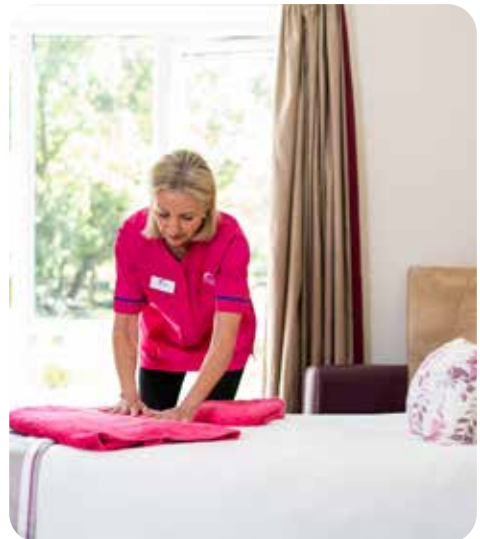
