Step outside and you'll find a garden full of charm, colour, and character, designed for relaxing, socialising, and soaking up a bit of nature.

There's a lovely mix of spaces to enjoy, from quiet corners to areas made for gathering.

A bar, gentle water features, and raised flowerbeds all add to the welcoming feel; while visiting birds and a cheeky family of squirrels bring a bit of extra life to the scene.

Residents with rooms overlooking the garden are encouraged to make their own outdoor patches feel personal - often adding bird feeders, gnomes, and bright bursts of bedding plants to reflect their own style. It's a simple touch that makes a big difference.

Another patio area, complete with extra seating and its own water feature, is a favourite spot for summer get-togethers and relaxed afternoons with family and friends.

Whether it's joining a gardening club or just enjoying the fresh air, this green space is a little sanctuary full of everyday joy.

A taste of home

Mealtimes here are about more than just food - they're a time to gather, share, and enjoy home-cooked meals together.

The kitchen team, led by experienced catering manager Tracy, prepares fresh, locally sourced dishes every day, ensuring every meal is both nutritious and delicious.

Residents have a strong say in the menu, with regular feedback sessions influencing the rotating dishes. Favourites include cheese and onion pie, Friday fish and chips, and hearty corned beef hash, while themed food events celebrate everything from Chinese New Year to summer BBQs. The in-house coffee shop serves freshly baked shortbreads, cookies, and pastries daily, offering a sweet treat for residents and visitors alike.

For birthdays and special occasions, residents receive personalised cakes based on their favourite flavours. One resident requested a 100-shaped birthday cake, while another enjoyed mussels in garlic sauce for their special day. Every meal is prepared with care, bringing warmth and familiarity to the dining experience.
