# Sweet comfort in *every bite*

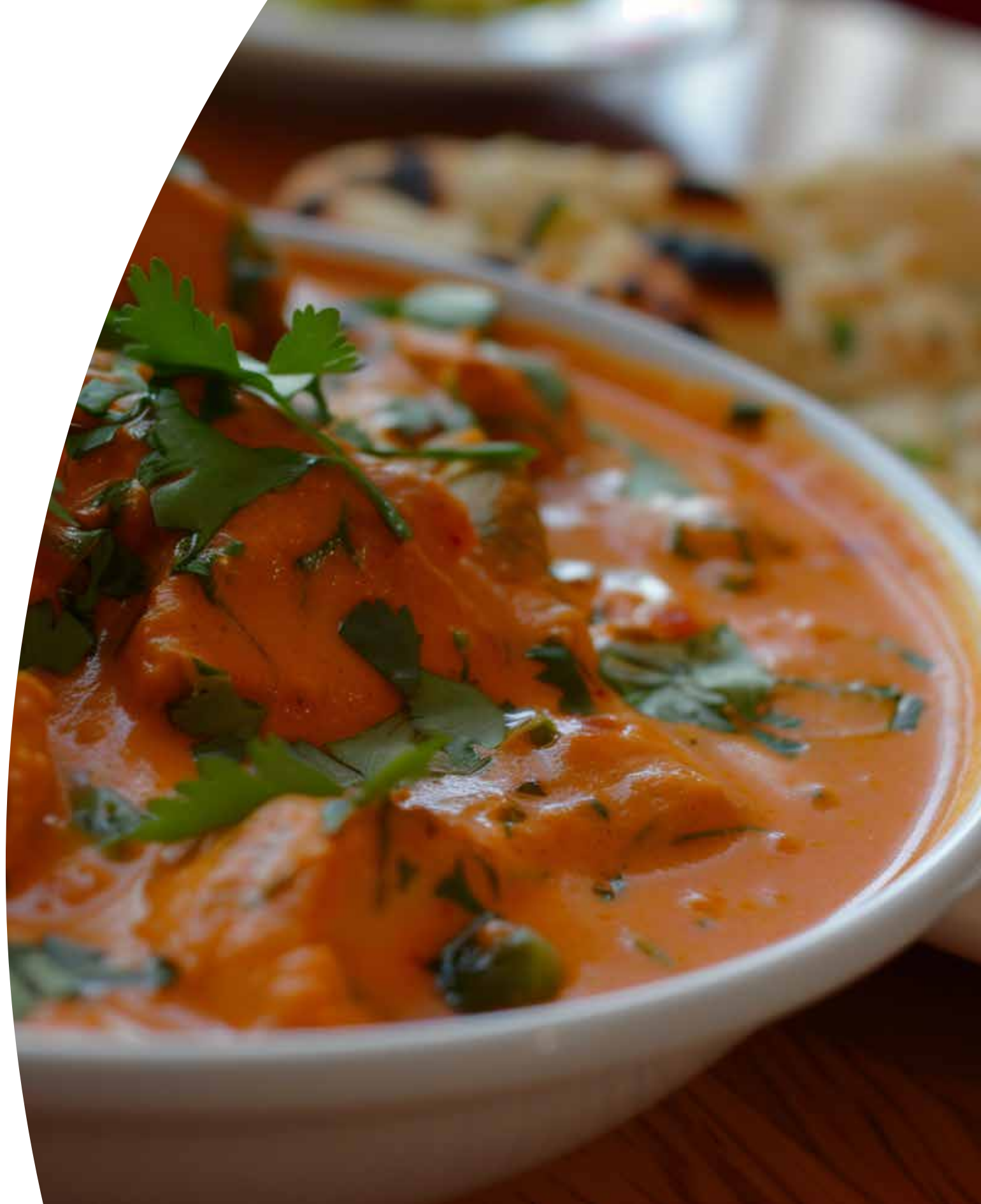

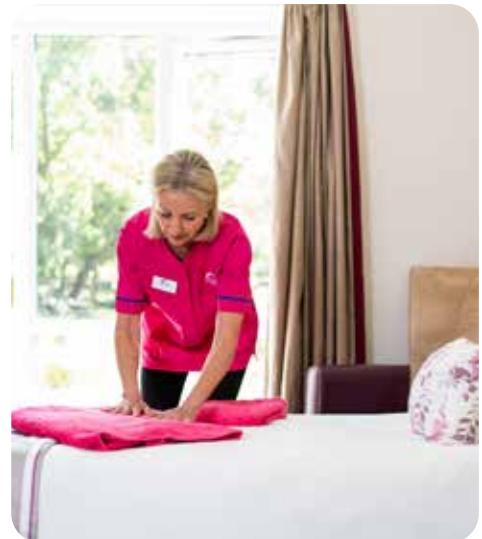
