Communal areas, including two lounges, a reading nook, and the tearoom, provide spaces to socialise, relax, and connect. Residents can enjoy pampering sessions in the salon or spend quiet moments watching the fish tank in the reception area - a favourite calming feature for many.

The Beeches also offers music therapy, where our residents who are living with dementia often find their voice through singing, and pastoral care from the chaplain, who leads weekly services and one-to-one sessions.
