Queensway House provides accommodation for up to 22 residents with enduring mental health needs and caters for younger people as well as other ages. Weston House caters for up to 48 older individuals with dementia and nursing care requirements.

The homes are surrounded by amenities and local landmarks such as Victoria Park and Stafford Castle. Victoria Park is just two miles away, offering residents and their families access to its award-winning flower gardens, bird aviary, and serene riverbanks.

At Weston & Queensway House, every detail is designed to create a space where residents feel at home, supported, and connected to the local community.
