Though set just off a main road, the long, private driveway leads to a peaceful hideaway surrounded by mature trees — the kind of space where you can hear the birds and catch the seasons changing. The garden room brings the outdoors in, with artificial grass underfoot, comfy seating, and a calming view of greenery. It's often used by our chaplain as a quiet spot for reflection or meaningful chats.

We've got lovely touches too, like Seashell Cove, a beachthemed room created with help from a resident's family, offering a gentle escape to the seaside without leaving the home.

Right next door, the local primary school brings joy and laughter through shared activities including decorating stones for the pathways and surprise visits that brighten everyone's day.

We're also lucky to have fantastic support from volunteers, who help on creative projects like our blossom tree mural. And outside, a special memorial tree stands as a thoughtful place to remember those we've loved.

Menus change with the seasons and are shaped by residents' input – if there's a favourite, we'll make it happen. Fish and chip Fridays are a weekly hit, as is our popular carrot and coriander soup. Our seafood dishes always go down a treat too.

The team's sweet treats are a real talking point – think freshly baked cakes, biscuits, and indulgent afternoon teas. Every birthday is celebrated with a bespoke cake, and we love getting families involved in special occasion spreads.

There's also The Gledhow Arms – our very own pub – perfect for pub lunches, catch-ups, and watching the big game together. It's more than food – it's nourishment, celebration, and connection.
