Tucked away at the bottom of Stainton Village, just off the A174, Montpellier Manor is perfectly placed in quiet residential surroundings with everything close to hand. There's a bus stop right outside the gates and Thornaby train station is just five minutes away. Shops, a post office, a local hairdresser, and even St Mary's Cathedral are all within easy reach and all ideal for a stroll or a little outing.

Inside, the home is modern, stylish, and purpose-built for both residential and dementia care, spread across three thoughtfully designed floors. The dementia household sits peacefully on the top floor, offering great views across the local area.

From the moment you walk into the vibrant coffee shop at the entrance - always buzzing with conversation and activity - you'll feel the warm, welcoming atmosphere. Families and residents often say it feels more like a boutique hotel than a care home, and the team members? They really do go above and beyond, every day.

A garden *for all seasons*

Our garden is a real favourite – a safe, generously sized outdoor space that runs the full length of the home and offers something for everyone. Whether you fancy a stroll, a bit of fresh air, or simply sitting back to watch the world (and the squirrels!) go by, it's all right here.

Some residents on the ground floor enjoy their own private patio spaces - perfect for a morning coffee, a good book, or watching the birds flutter past. Just off the lively coffee shop lounge, there's also a spacious shared patio where residents love to gather during the warmer months and soak up the atmosphere.

We're introducing raised flower beds too, making it easy for anyone with green fingers to get involved in a spot of gardening or veg growing. Residents collect lavender from the garden to make lavender bags and posies as part of autumnthemed crafts.

And when the sun's shining, the whole space comes alive especially during our outdoor summer festival - a joyful day of music, families, and fun with the local community.

Food that feels like home

We make sure our mealtimes are a real highlight. The kitchen team is known for going above and beyond - whether that's cooking up comfort food classics or whipping up themed treats for special occasions. They're always listening, taking part in regular resident meetings to shape menus around what people genuinely enjoy.

Meals are flexible and personalised, with the team happily going off-menu to suit individual preferences. Favourites include homemade cheese scones, daily soups like carrot & coriander or Scotch broth, and good old egg and chips. Sundays are all about the roast - so popular, even team members try to work that day!

From novelty cupcakes at Easter to personalised birthday cakes for every resident, there's a real sense of celebration here. Afternoon teas and baking sessions bring everyone together, and food-themed reminiscence activities often spark lovely memories.

Drinks trolleys make their rounds throughout the day, offering everything from fresh fruit to mocktails. With "Fruity Fridays" and "Thirsty Thursdays," hydration has never been more fun – or more delicious!
